



Peter Bunting earned a Bachelor's in Engineering (Mechanical) from McGill University in Montreal, Canada and a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Florida in Gainesville. As Co-founder and Chairman of Dehring Bunting & Golding (now ScotiaDBG) - Jamaica's first private sector investment banking firm with a track record of innovation and successful deal making - he earned a reputation for creative thinking and strategic action.

He entered representational politics, for a single term, in 1993 as the Member of Parliament for South East Clarendon and successfully re-entered that arena in 2007 as the Member of Parliament for Central Manchester. He now also serves as the General Secretary of the People's National Party and the Opposition Spokesperson on National Security.

In 2010, Peter re-entered the financial services sector with the launch of Proven Investments Limited (PIL – a St. Lucia-registered international business company), an investment company with a portfolio of regional and international securities. Within a few months of being established, PIL acquired Guardian Asset Management and renamed it Proven Wealth limited (PWL), where he now serves as Chairman of the Board.
